Your child should plan to attend this meeting with you, as we will go over behavior expectations and answer any questions they might have about camp as well.

At this meeting, we will also go over departure/arrival times, any packing questions you might have, and much more. And good news – there are no forms to notarize this year!

Enclosed are the various forms that you will need to fill out or read through:

- 1) *Highland Medical Release Form + Insurance Card* – Use the link to fill out your child's medical release form using the secure online platform, SmartWaiver.

In the "Pertinent Information," please share any medical history (surgeries, injuries, etc.) we may need to know about. In addition, please scan and email Renee a copy of your health insurance card.
- 2) *PASSPORTkids! Medical Release Form* – Use the link to fill out your child's medical release form using the secure online platform, SmartWaiver. www.passportcamps.org/hbclouisville-kids
- 3) *Transportation Permission Form* – One (1) copy, printed, signed
- 4) *Parent/Camper Information Page (color)* – Place this on your refrigerator! It includes a general packing list and important details about preparing for camp.
- 5) *Packing List* – Keep this handy as you pack! I've created a more specific list to assist you in making sure that your child has everything they need for camp.

I'm looking forward to a wonderful week at camp with your child as we think about our theme – ***Fearless***. Together, we will be exploring what it means to fear less and love more as we go through our life. 1 Corinthians 16:13 will ground our exploration as we learn to "Stay awake, stand firm in your faith, be brave, be strong. Everything should be done in love."
